#### **Roger McBride**

President McBride is the 2nd counselor in the Lakeville Stake and is vice president of Human Resources and Safety for Ames Construction. He was born and raised in Cache County, Utah. He served a mission to Arkansas little Rock and has served as bishop of the Burnsville and Prior Lake wards and as a branch president. Pres. McBride loves fishing and last year was able to fish the Bighorn in Montana and fish for trout in Ireland. He lives on a 10 acre hobby farm in Jordan, MN, which his wife Laurie says he sees only in the dark for 6 months of the year.
