Fancourt Babberly, another Oxford undergrad, who is a friend of Jack and Charley, shows up to show off a costume that he will be wearing in a school production. It happens to be a black satin dress of the sort worn by elderly ladies of the day. In a flash of brilliance Jack and Charley talk the reluctant Babbs into impersonating Charley's rich aunt, so that the afternoon can proceed without raising the eyebrows of the girl's overly zealous guardian. Babbs begins to warm to the idea, and plays his part to the hilt. During the course of the afternoon he gains the confidence of Kitty and Amy, and is proposed to by their guardian and Jack's father. Words cannot describe the comedy, both visual and verbal; this show has to be experienced.
